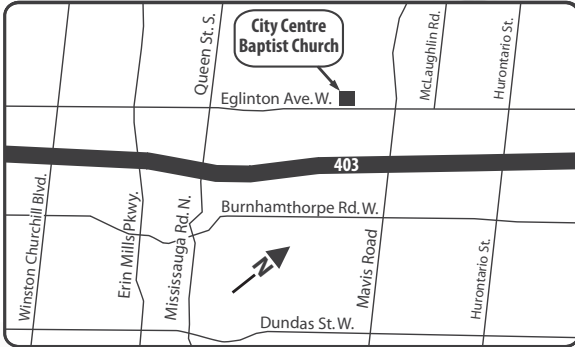

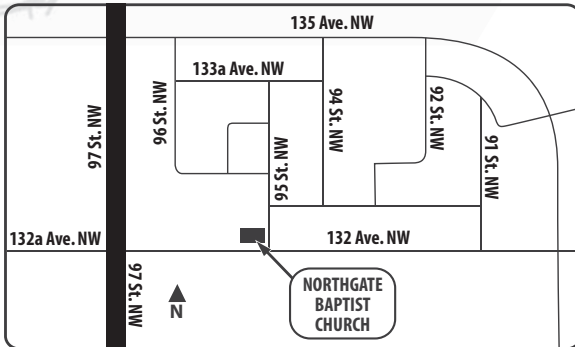

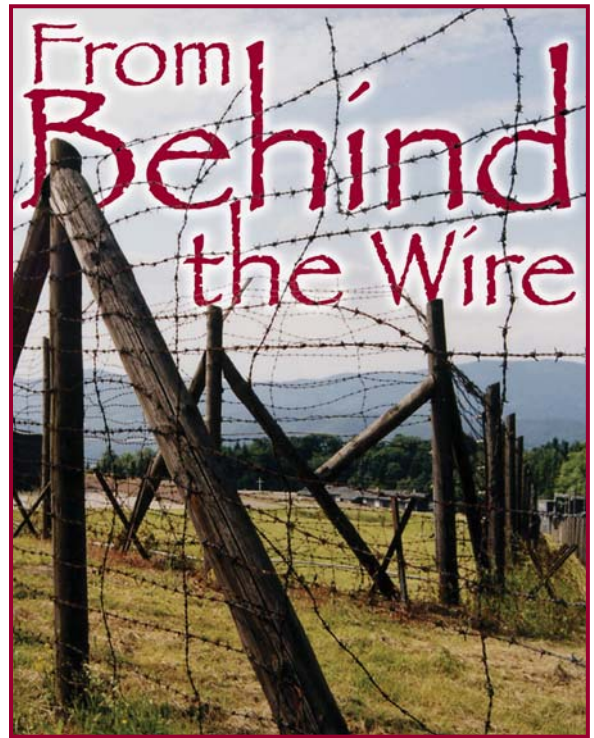

**Mr. Kim** - Mr. Kim was born in Hee-Chun City in North Korea in 1962. He served in the North Korean military for ten years, commissioned as a second lieutenant in the Art Propaganda Division and finally promoted to the rank of captain. One of his poems about the greatness of Kim Il Sung became required memorization by all North Korean soldiers. Gradually disillusioned by the deteriorating conditions in North Korea and his growing awareness of the outside world, Mr. Kim eventually escaped to China but was captured and brutally returned to the communist state. After a miraculous second escape, he lived in seclusion in China for two years and came to know the Lord Jesus Christ. Mr. Kim is the President of the Association of North Korean Defectors and founder of FreeNK Broadcasting. FreeNK's Korean language "Voice of Freedom" is the only daily half hour Gospel radio program focused on Christian persecution. It is broadcast on shortwave into North Korea amidst tremendous opposition from both North and South Korea.

**Glenn Penner** – VOMC's Chief Executive Officer and author of *In the Shadow of the Cross: A biblical theology of persecution and discipleship*. Glenn has ministered around the world on behalf of the persecuted church since 1997 and is regarded as one of Canada's leading experts on religious freedom.

**Eric Foley** – Eric Foley and his wife, Mrs. Ahn Hyun Sook, are the founders of Voice of the Martyrs Korea. Their primary calling is service to the North Korean church. The Foleys are regular columnists for Joong An Ilbo, the Korean Christian Times, the Korean Christian Newsweek network, and the Korean Christian Herald, in addition to being recurring guests on Korean radio and TV programs, Korean magazine publications, and Korean language Voice of America broadcasts.

**Trevor Dick** - Trevor Dick is a popular electric and acoustic violinist. He hails from Guelph, Ontario and has toured across Canada, the United States, South America and Africa. Trevor has released four albums (which will be available at the conference). We are pleased that he has agreed to bless us with his music and to lead us in worship at our conferences this year.
